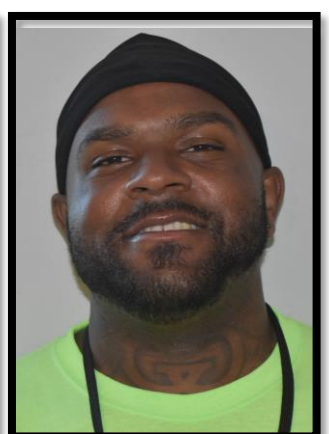

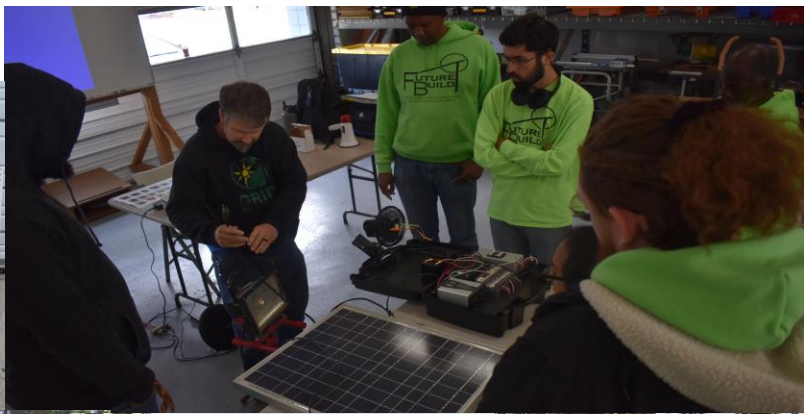


# Multi Craft Core Curriculum (MC3) Home Builders Institute (HBI)

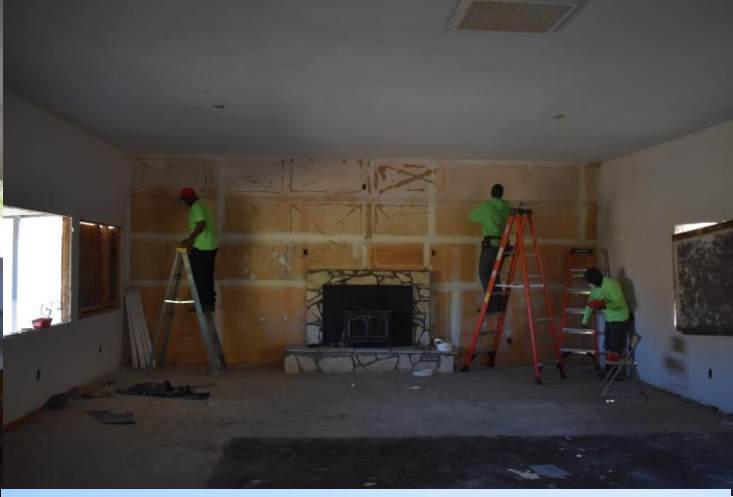

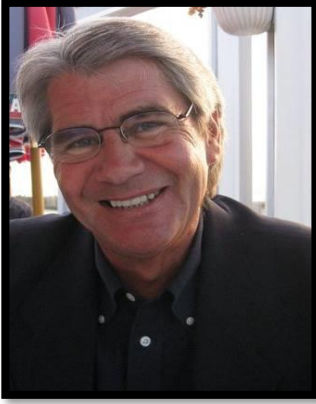
# Community Benefit Project - Pittsburg Police Range House. Phase One
